

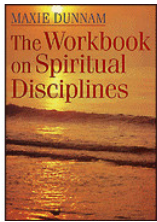
Wonderful Wednesday Winter 2010 Adult Classes

Workbook on Spiritual Disciplines (heart)

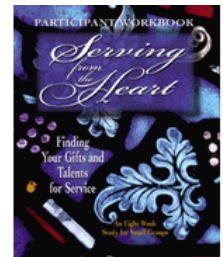

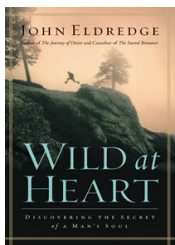
Serving From the Heart (hands)
